The Joyce Family at Ridgeway Farm have offered a part of their land adjoining the
public path that runs from Hartwell Road to Park Lane past the Roost.

The Woodland Trust gave us 105 trees to plant as a hedge beside the path and it
was agreed that they would be planted to form a boulevard. The trees will provide
year round colour and habitat for wildlife.

A small group of planters gathered on one morning in March and planted the hedge. The
subsequent rain has helped the saplings establish and they appear to be doing well.
The Parish Council will organize an afternoon visit to the site in a few weeks so that
villagers can see the hedge and the other trees planted there to form Ashton Jubilee
Woods. The Parish Council would like to thank Steve Falder, Rob Lemon, Phil Joyce
and Paul Joyce for their time and effort in planting the hedge.
