Following reorganisation Ashton is no longer with Hartwell but has been grouped with Grafton Regis, Alderton and Yardley Gobion. The ward has one seat with two candidates:-

Martin Wilson of Ashton - Martin has lived in Roade and Ashton for 28 years.

Ian Baxter of Old Stratford - Ian is the current councillor.

Ann Sale - Ann was born in Ashton and has spent all of her life in the village. She has been a member of the Parish Council for 20 years.




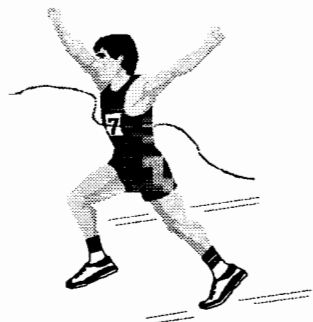
